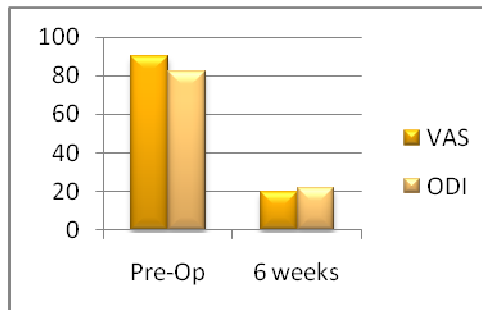
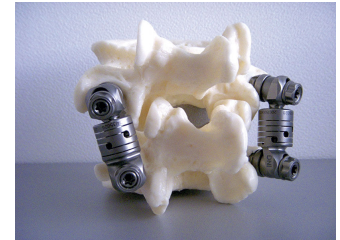
Neurologic Deficits and Pain
